[Tea Weekly](#) – Tea Area residents will vote on a bond issue June 20th. A 60% “yes” vote would approve the sale of \$15.4 million in bonds to finance the construction of a new Tea Area School District elementary school. The Tea Area student population is 1710, and this translates to larger classrooms and higher student-to-staff ratios, unless a new building is funded. Voting takes place on June 20th from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. in the District Education Center at 131 N. Poplar Avenue in Tea.

[SiouxFalls.Business](#) – Carrie Ann’s Boutique opened in Harrisburg. The clothing store, operating out of the Perfect Practice building on Cliff Avenue, is open from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Wednesday and Friday, from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, and from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday.

[SiouxFalls.Business](#) – Game Changer, a restaurant, opened in Harrisburg. It serves breakfast, lunch, and dinner, and is open from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. The restaurant, located next to Perfect Practice and the future trampoline park, Air Madness, has already hired 25 people. Air Madness is expected to create another 75 jobs, and hiring is expected to begin in the next few weeks. Both Air Madness and Game Changer are owned by Gary Sperber, the entrepreneur who created the indoor sports practice facility Perfect Practice.

[The Lennox Independent](#) – The Lennox Municipal Band has started performing for the season, and will continue to do so for the summer months. The band performs on Thursdays at 8 p.m. in the Jacobs Memorial Bandshell in Westerman Park, Lennox, and concerts are free and open to the public.

Sioux Valley News – Canton will break ground on Monday, June 12th at 6:30 p.m. on a new performing arts center. The project is estimated to cost up to \$11.6 million, and is one of the largest constructions in the school district since Bid-Well built their factory in 2011. In addition, the Canton Municipal Pool opened on Monday, with a newly-installed frog slide.
