[Lennox Independent](#) – Lennox will receive \$4.678 million to update ageing sewer and water infrastructure. The updates should increase drinking water quality and pressure while upgrading the sanitary sewers and further directing storm water flow away from homes.

[Garretson Gazette](#) – Entrepreneur Omar Thornton’s new restaurant, O-So-Good, opened July 8th in downtown Garretson. The location will serve soul food, feature a selection of candies and treats, and offer both a coffee bar and a beer and wine selection.

[News.SD.Gov](#) – Hendrix Genetics, a Dutch company, will construct a \$25 million turkey hatchery in Beresford. The hatchery will employ 50 people and construction will begin in August.

[Lennox Independent](#) – The Only One Bar and Grill has completed their remodel, adding 25 seats and 1600 square feet. The venue features remodeled bathrooms and a larger kitchen, which accommodates an expanded menu.

Minnehaha Messenger – Hartford will receive a \$1.482 million loan from the state Board of Water and Natural Resources to finance water and sewer construction in the southeast part of that city. The entire project is set to cost \$6.43 million, and the loan matures in 30 years with a 2.5% rate of interest.

[SiouxFalls.Business](#) – Festivals in regional communities lead to more sales, but also foster a sense of community that cannot be given a price. While most occur in June, Brandon, Baltic, Colton, Canton, and Worthing will still host activities later this summer.
